Key Line

Let's be honest. I don't want to be associated with some church people. Some church people are hard to love.

Seek the Word

Sometimes church people argue over small things.

- Give an example of something some Christian people think is important but isn't really essential to salvation (*playing cards, wearing certain clothes, singing a certain type of songs, using a certain translation of the Bible*).

Read John 9:1-41.

- What question did the people ask when they saw the blind man? (*Who sinned that caused this man's blindness? Him or his parents?*)
- What did Jesus call himself? (*The light of the world.*) What did he mean by this? (*He was going to show them what God was like by his next actions.*)
- Why did the religious people/Pharisees get upset and doubt that Jesus was from God? (*Jesus didn't act according to what they thought he should have acted.*)
- According to verse 39, Jesus said he came to the world so "the blind will see and those who see will become blind." What does that mean? (*He will open the eyes of those who do not understand who God is and change their understanding of who he is and what it means to follow him.*)

Talk About It

- How can you tell if you are suffering from spiritual blindness? (*Honesty and humility*)
- Give some specific ways that you can remain honest and humble in your spiritual life.
