<p><b>WEEK 1</b> 1/11/2017</p>	<p>Wisdom is found on the lips of the discerning, but a rod is for the back of one who has no sense. Proverbs 10:13</p>	<p>This week we talked about DISCERNMENT (being able to tell the difference between right and wrong). Sometimes it is easy to DISCERN what is right, and other times we need to pray and ask God to help us discern. One great question to ask when making tough decisions is WHAT WOULD JESUS DO? This week your challenge is to make a poster that says either "WHAT WOULD JESUS DO?" or "WWJD?". You can do it on any size paper. You can do it from scratch or use the computer. Be as creative as you'd like. Bring it to show your leader next week, then take it back home and put it in a spot where you will see it often!</p>
<p><b>WEEK 2</b> 1/18/2017</p>	<p>Let your yes be YES. Let your no be NO. Anything more than this comes from the devil. Matthew 5:37 (NLV)</p>	<p>God keeps ALL of His promises; He is ALWAYS true to His word. He wants us to keep all of our promises as well. This week your challenge is to find at least ONE of God's many promises in the Bible that He has kept. Write it down (or draw a picture of it) and bring it to show your leaders next week.</p>
<p><b>WEEK 3</b> 1/25/2017</p>	<p>Like a city whose walls are broken down is a man who lacks self-control. Proverbs 25:28</p>	<p>Your challenge this week is to create a fort with walls of protection. You can use Legos, blocks, blankets, etc. Once your fort is built, show it to a grown-up. Then knock down the walls and discuss the meaning of your memory verse with him/her (Proverbs 25:28). If you complete this challenge, simply ask your parent or other grown up to sign this page in your book (or send a note) and bring it to show your leaders next week.</p>
<p><b>WEEK 4</b> 2/1/2017</p>	<p>Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters. Colossians 3:23</p>	<p>This week we talked about DILIGENCE (working hard without getting distracted or stopping). Your challenge is to copy down the phrase "<b>Start FAST, work HARD, finish STRONG</b>" onto at least two sticky notes (even more would be great!). Stick them in your bible to show your leaders next week. Then take them back home and put them in certain places (like in your room, in your school notebooks, etc.) to help cheer you on the next time you need some encouragement to be DILIGENT!</p>
<p><b>WEEK 5</b> 2/8/2017</p>	<p>But here is what I tell you. Love your enemies. Pray for those who hurt you. Matthew 5:44 (NIRV)</p>	<p>Next week is Valentine's Day, and so tonight we talked about LOVE. Your challenge is to look up 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 and write down a list of <u>at least 10 qualities</u> of Godly love (for example "it is not rude"). If you have extra time, you can write down ALL of the qualities listed in these verses. Bring your list to show your leader next week.</p>
