TEXT

John 11

TRUTH

*In Jesus, we discover the life that
God has created us to live.*

▶ **START HERE**

When you were a kid, what did you think
life would be like as an adult?

SEEK THE WORD

- The passage is long today: **John 11:1-44**. Settle in, take turns, and feel free to stop each other to ask questions!
- How did Martha react when Jesus came?
- When Jesus said Lazarus would rise again, what did Martha think he meant? What did he actually mean?
- How did Jesus respond to the suffering he saw in Mary and the other mourners?
- In **verse 25**, Jesus makes his bold 'I am' statement: 'I am the resurrection and the life.' These are two different things, written in a specific order. How do 'resurrection' and 'life' fit together?
- What evidence does he give for being the resurrection and the life?

TALK ABOUT IT

- Besides being physically dead, are there other ways that people can be 'dead?' What does it look like for Jesus to have power over these areas, as well?
- How do people receive the life that Jesus offers?
- Many of us have had the experience of being angry at God for allowing something to happen that we wish he wouldn't have. How do you process this?
- When Jesus restored physical life to Lazarus, people noticed. When Jesus gives spiritual life to someone that places their belief in him, how do other people know or notice?

WHAT NOW?

- Spend some time talking in your group about what's next! If your group will continue – what have we done or talked about that could help guide how we spend our time together and who we serve together?
- If your group is finishing up – how does Jesus being worth following affect our daily lives?
