

# 2018 IGNITE SUMMER CAMP

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What's Ignite?**

Ignite is a summer camp for kids going into 4th and 5th grades this fall. It runs from Sunday, July 8 to Wednesday, July 11, and is held at Covenant Cedars Bible Camp in Hordville, NE. Check out [www.cedars.org](http://www.cedars.org) to see photos and an awesome video of the campground!



Kids will have large group sessions with worship and teaching, small group time to discuss and read the Bible, quiet time, games, and structured time for activities. Activities could be swimming in the lake or pool, crate stacking, zip lining, campfires, etc!

### **How much does it cost?**

Cost of the camp is \$200 per student.

### **When & how do I register and pay?**

Registration is live online at [calvary.ch/kids](http://calvary.ch/kids)!

You can pay online with the registration, but if you'd like to pay with check or cash, simply check 'pay later!' If you're interested in a scholarship, please talk with your campus kids ministry staff (see below)!

*\*Registration is on a first come, first serve basis, and spots are limited, so register right away!\**

### **Who will be at camp with my child?**

Calvary Kids staff will be there! That staff, as well as any of our adult volunteers, are background checked and trained. Because this camp partners with a few other churches, those church staffs will be around as well, and they are leaders that are Calvary Kids team works with regularly, knows, and trusts. However, Calvary kids will be with Calvary leaders!

### **Can my child bring a friend to camp?**

Of course - we'd love to have them! Make sure to write their name on the group preference question on the form, so we can try to keep them together for groups!

### **Safety information?**

Children will always be accompanied by adults. Life jackets will be provided and must be worn at all times in activities at the lake. Life guards will be on duty at the pool. We will also have a nurse with us to assist with first aid, medications and medical needs, and Covenant Cedars has a nurse who can assist with medical emergencies.

### **How will my kids get to this camp?**

We will take 15 passenger vans that will depart from and return to our Calvary Bellevue campus.

### **Can I drive my own kid to and from camp?**

If you'd like to, yes! However, we'd highly encourage you to caravan from Calvary so that we all arrive at camp together! If you're interested in doing this, please communicate with your campus kids ministry staff!

**What about sleeping?**

Kids will sleep with a larger group of other Calvary kids and adults in a lodge/cabin. They get up at 7:30am and lights are out at 10:15pm each night.

**Can you accommodate my camper's special needs?**

We will work with the camp staff to help accommodate food allergies, and will administer meds as needed. For any other concerns or accommodations, please chat with your campus kids ministry staff!

**What does my camper need to pack?**

- \_ Bible, pen or pencil, and a journal if you use it!
- \_ Clothes: four days' worth of normal clothes, sleeping clothes, anything to wear during rec time, and a swimsuit!
- \_ Toiletry items: towel, shower items, medicines, toothbrush/paste, deodorant, hair items, sunscreen, etc.
- \_ Bedding: pillow and either a sleeping bag or blankets.
- \_ Optional money: the two places students might use money are for the offering taken for missions and a small canteen to buy things like snacks!
