<p>WEEK 1 9/5/2018</p>	<p>When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here! 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NirV)</p>	<p>This week is about BEING MADE NEW. When we choose to accept Jesus into our lives, He wipes our sins away so that we are made "new"! Your challenge is to get a crisp, new, clean sheet of paper (any kind). Choose to do something special with that paper - you can draw a picture, make it into a paper airplane, etc. If you mess up, you can try again with a NEW sheet. <p>WEEK 3 9/19/2018</p>	<p>And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased. Hebrews 13:16</p>	<p>This week was all about SHARING. Seems easy enough, doesn't it? Well, it's easy to give someone something small that doesn't matter to us. But sometimes it is really hard to share our things (or our time!) with others. Your challenge this week is to think of something that would be a sacrifice for you to share -- something that you treasure, but you feel like God wants you to give away. Talk to your parents about this. Have your parents sign your book as proof of completion.</p>
