8/28/2019 BELLEVUE CAMPUS ONLY	Listen, my sons, to a father's instruction; pay attention and gain understanding. Proverbs 4:1	This week we talked about LISTENING. Since Grandparent's Day is coming up soon, your challenge is to ask a grandparent (or an 'adopted' grandparent) to tell you a story from their childhood. To complete this challenge you must either write out the story, draw a picture of the story or video the story and bring it to show your leaders next week. Remember to be a very good listener!
9/4/2019	Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Colossians 3:20	Tonight we talked about being more like Jesus by being OBEDIENT! This week we want you to try to: 1) obey your parents by doing the whole job (not half), 2) obey right away, and 3) obey with a good attitude! Your challenge is to look up Ephesians 6:1-3 and write down two reasons WHY you should obey. Bring the two written answers with you to show your leaders next week.
9/11/2019	I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. Philippians 4:11b	This week we talked about CONTENTMENT. Look up Philippians 4:12-13. Here it talks about the "secret" to contentment. This week you have a two-part challenge: 1) What is the "secret"? 2) Who wrote these verses (who wrote the book of Philippians)? Come back ready to share these two things with your leaders to complete the challenge.
9/18/2019	For God is not a God of disorder but of peace 1 Corinthians 14:33a	This week we talked about ORDERLINESS. Your challenge is to look around your house for an area that could use some order. It might be a closet, or a drawer, or your room! Once you have decided on your "project" be sure to take a 'BEFORE' PICTURE. Then spend some time organizing the area and take an 'AFTER' PICTURE. Bring your BEFORE & AFTER pictures to show your leaders next week. If you cannot bring pictures, a parent can send a note as proof of completion.
9/25/2019	And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. Micah 6:8b	God shows us MERCY and forgives us all the time. He does not give us the punishment we deserve. He wants us to show mercy to others as well. Your challenge this week is to write THREE SENTENCES to finish the phrase "Mercy is" For example: Mercy isinviting someone to play with me that just cut in front of me in the lunch line. Mercy isdoing something kind for the teacher after she yelled at me. Bring your THREE sentences with you next week to show your leader.
