Introduction

Last week we wrapped up our Different series. We talked for several weeks about how Jesus calls us to look different from the rest of the world in a variety of ways. This week we get to kick off a new series called EveryONE. Jesus is for everyone, and Christians are called to seek out the people in their lives who do not know Jesus. Today we are going to talk about how the Church all share the same heart.

- Tell a short story of a memorable invitation you either did or did not receive. (A birthday party, a wedding, a school dance, etc.)

Seek the Word

Read Romans 10:10-15.

- What does verse 12 tell us about who Jesus cares for?
- How does this passage explain that people can be saved?
- Why does this passage say it is important to seek out those who do not know Jesus?
- What responsibilities does this passage give Christ followers?
- What does this passage tell us about God’s heart?

Go Deeper

Our main passage this week is from Romans. To go deeper on the topic of sharing Jesus, take some time to compile a short list of Bible stories of people going out of their way to show Jesus to others. This will be helpful to use as a reference in other studies. A concordance, Blue Letter Bible app, or the Logos app may be helpful.

Talk About It

- How did you first hear about Jesus? Was it through another person?
- Are you currently committed to showing anyone Jesus consistently? Who are they?
- What are some ways you can commit to your one this holiday season?
- How can we, as a group, help encourage you to love your one this week?

Wrap Up

Reminder: It is our responsibility to influence and invite people towards Jesus.

Challenge: As we approach the holiday season, take some time to create a list of ways to show Jesus to your one life. Commit to doing some of the items on the list in the next few weeks.

They can be as small as sending encouraging texts, or bigger - like inviting them to spend a holiday with you. If you do not have a one life you are committed to already, your challenge is to decide on one person in your life who does not know Jesus well or at all. Whoever you choose, commit to showing them Jesus and leading them to Him.
