## Introduction

This week we are continuing our EveryONE series. We are talking about how it is our responsibility to have conversations about Jesus with those who do not know him. Last week we talked about how we can lead others to Jesus with love. Let's focus on how we can have these conversations with love.

- Where does this passage tell us to go preach?
- What can this passage tell us about God's heart?

Read Romans 10:13.

- How does this passage explain part of who God is?

## Go Deeper

This week we talked about how each person is unique in how they reach people. Create a list of people in the Bible and take some time identifying which style of evangelism they might be using (Direct, Intellectual, Testimonial, Interpersonal, Invitational, Serving).

## Talk About It

- Who is one person that helped influence and lead you to Jesus?
- There are a few different ways to reach people (Direct, Intellectual, Testimonial, Interpersonal, Invitational, Serving). Which do you most relate to?
- How have you been able to encourage your one life this past week? If you do not have a one life, are there people you have been able to encourage?
- Has God put anything on your heart this past week? How can you listen to what He is saying to you?

## Wrap Up

*Challenge:* Take some time to think about the people who have influenced and lead you towards Jesus in your own life. Think about the things they did that influenced you. Choose one of those things and do that same thing to someone else in your life this week.
