"Did Jesus Have A Life Purpose? (Part 2)"

Introduction

Last week we began to discuss the question, "did Jesus have a life purpose?" This week we are continuing to work through this question. We landed on this reminder last week: God's will is for you to adopt His mission to seek and save the lost. As we continue to look at this question, we'll begin to understand our purpose in serving others.

• Have you ever had a desire to be great at something? (Singing, writing, cooking, etc.)

Seek the Word

- Read Joshua 1. What servant leadership can you glean from this passage, particularly since *Joshua* is the Hebrew name for Jesus.
- Read 1 Corinthians 9:19, 2 Corinthians 4:5, and 1 Peter
 5:2-3. How do these passages reinforce Jesus's teaching on servant leadership?

Go Deeper

There are certain psalms in the book of Psalms that foreshadow Jesus and His purpose. Using your Bible, and maybe another tool like a Bible concordance, create a brief list of psalms that foreshadow Jesus and His purpose of seeking and saving the lost.

Talk About It

- What have you learned about servant leadership from secular sources? Any principles that stand out to you as ones modeled by Jesus?
- Share about a time when you practiced servant leadership. What was the result?
- Where do you find it most difficult to serve humbly? Why do you think it's hard for you to serve those people or in those ways?

Wrap Up

Challenge: Do one thing this week for someone else that is uncomfortably humbling for you.
