Introduction

Seek the Word

- Read Mark 13:28-31. How does this statement about the enduring nature of God's Word impact your view of Scripture?
- Read Hebrews 4:12-13. How does this passage challenge you to view the Bible not just as a historical text, but as a living and powerful force in your life?

Go Deeper

Read Matthew 7:24-27. How does this parable illustrate the importance of building our lives on the foundation of God's Word? How can we make sure that we build our faith on a foundation of truth?

Talk About It

- Think about a specific area of your life where you've been struggling to align with God's Word. How can you apply the wisdom of Scripture to address this challenge?
- Reflect on your response to commitment #2 from the message building your life on the wisdom of God's Word. What practical changes can you make to ensure that you're actively applying biblical principles in your daily decisions and actions?
- Share about a recent experience where you saw the fruit of applying God's Word in your life or the life of someone you know. How did this experience strengthen your faith?

Wrap Up

Reminder: God's word can change your life.

Challenge: Take time this week to set aside 10-15 minutes each day for personal Bible reading and prayer. Choose a quiet place where you can focus without distractions. Dedicate time after to pray for spiritual growth, understanding of God's Word, and the strength to live according to His will. Ask God to guide you through any doubts or struggles you may encounter and to deepen your trust in His Word.
