## Introduction

- Read I Peter 4:1-2. Share the challenges of having the same attitude of Christ when things are not going so well in your life?
- I Peter 4:12 Share of a time when you faced a "fiery ordeal" in your life. How did God pull you through it?
- I Peter 4:5-7 What are the challenges of not living as the world lives today? Share why you are/are not looking forward to Jesus' return.
- I Peter 4:8-12 What in this passage sticks out to you as though Peter is speaking directly to you at this time?

#### Talk About It

Ryan shared four questions for you to consider at the end of his message. How would you go about answering them in your life right now?

- Are you thinking rightly about God and eternity? If not, why not
- Are you living in light of God and eternity? If not, what is holding you back
- Are you praying in light of God and eternity? Share about your prayer life. Is it strong?
- Are you using the gifts God has given you? Why do you enjoy serving? What areas of service do you need to jump into?
